Scholarship Information

As a high school senior who has taken at least one academic year of culinary classes in high school or has participated for at least one academic year in a culinary related organization (ProStart, C-CAP, SkillsUSA or FCCLA), you have proven your interest in the food service industry. Recognizing the motivation and potential you have already shown, Culinary Institute of Virginia (CIV) has a \$2,000 scholarship opportunity especially for you.

Scholarship awards will be distributed evenly each semester over the length of the Associate's degree program, and can be applied only toward tuition and fees. This scholarship can only be combined with the following CIV sponsored scholarships: Rising Senior Summer Camp, Early Action and Culinary Decathlon. Students must be enrolled and attending CIV prior to October 1, 2017.

Application Requirements

- Completed one academic year of culinary classes in high school or be an active participant of ProStart, C-CAP, SkillsUSA or FCCLA for at least one academic year
- Submit one letter of recommendation from the teacher or sponsor of the qualifying class or organization.
- Submit a copy of your current High School Transcript.
- Complete an Application to the Culinary Institute of Virginia, with an expected start date in the Fall of 2017.
