Competition Information

The contestants in the culinary decathlon will be evaluated in 10 different areas broken down into three categories. These categories are:

- Basic Culinary Knowledge Quiz
- Demonstration of Culinary Skills
- Presentation of Entrée

Rules: Entrants cannot provide any of their own ingredients. *All ingredients will be provided by CIV.* Students must provide their own knives. The judging panel's decision is final.

Scholarship Awards

Scholarships will be awarded to the top six students as listed below. Scholarship awards will be distributed evenly each semester over the course of two academic years. Scholarship awards can only be applied toward tuition and fees. Students must be enrolled and attending CIV on or before September 30, 2019.
