## \$2,000 Head-Start Scholarship Requirements

### **Scholarship Information**

As a high school senior who has taken at least one academic year of culinary classes in high school or has participated in a culinary related organization (ProStart, C-CAP, SkillsUSA or FCCLA), you have proven your interest in the food service industry. Recognizing the motivation and potential you have already shown, Culinary Institute of Virginia (CIV) has a \$2,000 scholarship opportunity especially for you.

Scholarship awards will be distributed evenly each semester over the course of two academic years. Scholarship awards can only be applied toward tuition and fees. This scholarship cannot be combined with CIV sponsored scholarships for high school organization competitions. Students must be enrolled and attending CIV on or before August 31, 2020.

### **Application Requirements**

- Completion of an Application and Acceptance to CIV, with an expected start date on or before August 31, 2020.
- Complete one academic year of culinary classes in high school or be an active participant of ProStart, C-CAP, SkillsUSA or FCCLA for one academic year.
- Submit one letter of recommendation from the teacher or sponsor of the qualifying class or organization.
- Submit a copy of your current High School Transcript.
