

# Norfolk Tourism Foundation Culinary Scholarship

### **Program Information**

A fun and hip downtown area, multiple outdoor activities, historical sites and museums attract visitors from all over to Norfolk, Virginia. Tourism in this destination city has created an energetic business environment with a solid food service industry. For those passionate about culinary arts, employment and externship opportunities can be found in upscale hotels, award-winning restaurants, bustling food trucks, and exciting concert venues just to name a few!

For that reason, the Norfolk Tourism Foundation (NTF) has partnered with the Culinary Institute of Virginia (CIV) to provide two (2) high school graduates from a Norfolk Public School the opportunity to earn \$2,000 scholarships towards a degree in culinary arts. The winners will be notified on Friday, April 24, 2020 and will be publicly awarded their scholarship at the Champions of Hospitality Rally on Tuesday, May 5, 2020.

Scholarship awards will be distributed evenly each semester over the course of two academic years. Scholarship awards can only be applied toward tuition and fees. Students must be enrolled and attending CIV on or before August 31, 2020.

### **Application Requirements**

- Acceptance to CIV, with an expected start date on or before August 31, 2020.
- Graduate from a Norfolk Public High School by June 15, 2020.
- Completion of the NTF Culinary Scholarship Application Form.
- Submit a personal essay (500 word maximum) explaining how after attending CIV, you can positively impact tourism through the food and beverage industry.
- Submit one letter of recommendation from a high school teacher or administrator, or an employer.
