

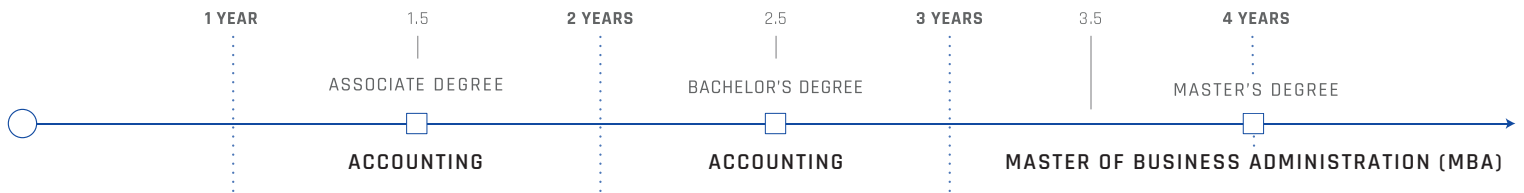


ACCOUNTING
