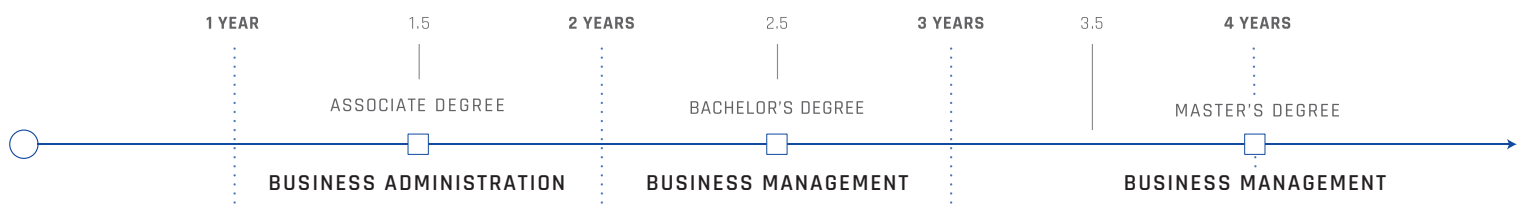
Designed for business management majors and their equivalents, this program covers theoretical, practical, and applied skills in leadership, business systems analysis, advanced human resources management, and the technologies which support these roles. **Students can choose between two concentrations:**

- Organizational Leadership
- Human Resources Management

Organizational Leadership involves managing people and processes in multicultural, global, and virtual environments. ECPI University's Organizational Leadership degree program promotes level-headed decision-making in complex situations, using strategy, best practices, and organizational policies and procedures.

Human Resources Management involves overseeing all the employees and related administrative functions within an organization, while simultaneously ensuring that business practices remain ethical and compliant. ECPI University's HR management degree program focuses on compliance and the regulatory environment from a legal perspective, strategic incentives which motivate a contemporary workforce, and digital tools and systems used by HR for management.
