The 2018 graduation rate for the Newport News location is based on the same formula, using a 2014 cohort, as the location was not open during the 2012 IPEDS cohort year. The 2017 graduation rate is not available, as the location was not open long enough to be able to calculate a 150% graduation rate.

*Job Placement Rate* is the percentage of students that are employed in their field of study within nine (9) months of graduation.
