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High School Early Action Scholarship Requirements

Scholarship Information

Culinary Institute of Virginia (CIV) wants to reward those students who make an early commitment to their educational goals by offering the Early Action Scholarship worth up to \$1,000.

Scholarship awards will be distributed evenly each semester over the length of the program. Scholarship awards can be applied only toward tuition and fees. Students must be enrolled and attending CIV prior to October 1, 2016.

Application Requirements

- Fill out the High School Early Action Scholarship Application.
- Submit a personal essay (500 word maximum) explaining what has inspired you to pursue a career in professional food service and why you feel this career is a good fit for you.
- Submit one letter of recommendation from a teacher, counselor or school administrator.
- Submit a copy of your current High School Transcript.

Selection Procedure

Scholarship recipients will be selected based upon the following criteria:

- Demonstration of a cumulative grade point average of 2.75 or higher.
- Completion of an Application to the Culinary Institute of Virginia, with an expected start date in the Fall of 2016.
